WHAT TO WEAR:

Instrumentalists

Full Marching Band Uniform

Color Guard

Full Guard Uniform

Including: black socks (no low cut, must be ankle or higher)
black shorts/leggings underneath bibbers
this year's gray band shirt underneath bibbers

9:00 AM	Band doors open, load truck and minibus
10:00 AM	Call time, double check all uniform parts, instruments, equipment, etc. BAND: Change into bibbers/shoes/black socks/band shirt, fix hair to be ready to place in shako. Guard: Change into full uniform.
11:00 AM	Load buses
11:30 AM	Depart
12:00 PM	Arrive at Lincoln-Way West H.S., unload, setup, get into full uniform
1:30 PM	Pit ready to move
1:45 PM	Pit warmup, everyone else ready to move
2:00 PM	Band/Guard warmup
2:15 PM	Pit travel
2:30 PM	Band/Guard travel
2:45 PM	Bremen Marching Band Performance
3:00 PM	Return to buses/truck, after everything is away watch bands, eat dinner
6:15 PM	1A and 2A awards
9:00 PM	The final band performs in exhibition
9:15 PM	Go to the buses immediately following the final performance, attendance
9:30 PM	Approximate departure
10:15 PM	Approximate dismissal after the buses and the truck are unloaded and everything is properly put away

Reminders: You will need \$ for dinner from the concessions. \$10 is recommended for a meal. Bring a little more \$ if you want snacks. You may bring your own food, too. You are not allowed to hang out or wait on the buses during the day. No eating while in uniform. Water is the only drink allowed while in uniform. Hydrate before, during, and after the performance. Bring your water bottle. Band students: Contest performances are summative grades.

While in uniform you are representing the Bremen Marching Band, Bremen High School, and Bremen H.S. District #228. Your actions, your words, your appearance, your attitude, and your performance are all reflections of the Bremen Music Department, your school community, your family, and yourself.
